
However, the Let's Help Tijuana initiative and the Tijuana Zonkeys executive team have agreed that the facilities will continue as they are right now with O2 lines, compressed air, beds, air filtration systems and other important adjustments that will remain intact in case of being required again.

This is because the Zonkeys Auxiliary Hospital only represents one wing of the double effort of Let's Help Tijuana, which will continue to supply medical equipment, food and hygiene products to the community.
